MIDLAND BULL TEST – AUTHORIZATION TO TEST

By signing below, you authorize Midland Bull Test to act as your agent for the above listed bulls in the following circumstances:

- 1. Submission of any required or requested genetic testing.
- 2. Requesting information from respective breed associations.
- 3. Sale and transfer of bulls eligible and authorized to sell.

Midland Bull Test reserves the exclusive right to market tissue/blood samples along with data of performance and efficiency testing for use in genome research. In return, consignors will only be charged \$75/head for efficiency testing.

Midland Bull Test business is regulated by the Packers and Stockyards Act. As such, there are various rules we are required to follow.

We respectfully request a signed waiver for the following rule regarding the Midland Bull Test Final Sort Sale:

201.43 (a) Market agencies to make prompt accounting and transmittal of net proceeds. Each market agency shall, before the close of the next business day following the sale of any livestock consigned to it for sale, transmit or deliver to the consignor or shipper of the livestock, or the duly authorized agent, in the absence of any knowledge that any other person, or persons, has any interest in the livestock, the net proceeds received from the sale and a true written account of such sale, showing the number, weight, and price of each kind of animal sold, the date of sale, the commission, yardage, and other lawful charges, and such other facts as may be necessary to complete the account and show fully the true nature of the transaction.

Historically, proceed checks are issued net your outstanding balance within three weeks of the end of the sale. MBT would like to continue this practice. The exception to issuing checks within three weeks would be any consignor that has failed to provide all the required paperwork related to the sale and transfer of title of the livestock sold. In order to pay a consignor within three weeks of the sale date, we request you sign this waiver.
